OUR MISSION

The mission of Crossings Christian School is to partner with parents and church to develop students into Christ-centered servant leaders who are academically and spiritually prepared for college and life.

OUR SCHOOL

Founded in 2001 with just 39 preschool students, Crossings Christian School is now the largest private school in Oklahoma City with almost 1,200 students in preschool through twelfth grade. The tremendous growth is indicative of our community's desire for a school with a college preparatory curriculum in a Christian environment.

In the 2020-21 school year

- approximately 13% of students represent diverse backgrounds
- approximately 20% of students received tuition assistance

OUR CURRICULUM

For the upper school, the academic program is organized by seven 50 minute class periods. The academic year is divided into two semesters, each approximately 18 weeks in length. Students are required to take six, for-credit classes per semester. All students must earn 24 credits to graduate and many earn the Distinguished Achievement diploma which requires 27 credits. In addition, each student must complete the 100 hour service hour community service graduation requirement.

COVID-19 RESPONSE

In spring 2020, CCS shifted to remote learning for the rest of the school year. While the well-being of our teachers and students was the priority, our expectations remained high and teaching and learning continued. Assignments were graded and tests and quizzes were administered. Students earned grades that reflected the mastery of the course content. With Covid-19 protocols in place, CCS returned to in-person school for the 2020-21 school year. No disruption of learning took place in 2021-22.

If a student has been found responsible for a disciplinary violation that results in out-of-school suspension in grades 9 through 12, it is Crossing Christian School's policy to report the incident to any college or university that requests such information.

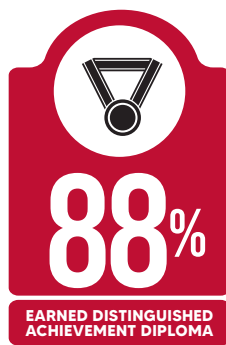

- With the exception of Valedictorian and Salutatorian, school policy eliminated class rank beginning with the Class of 2011.

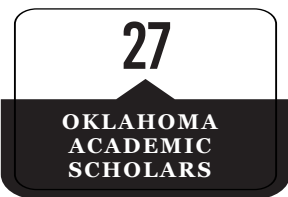
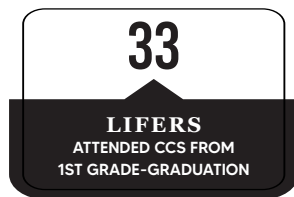

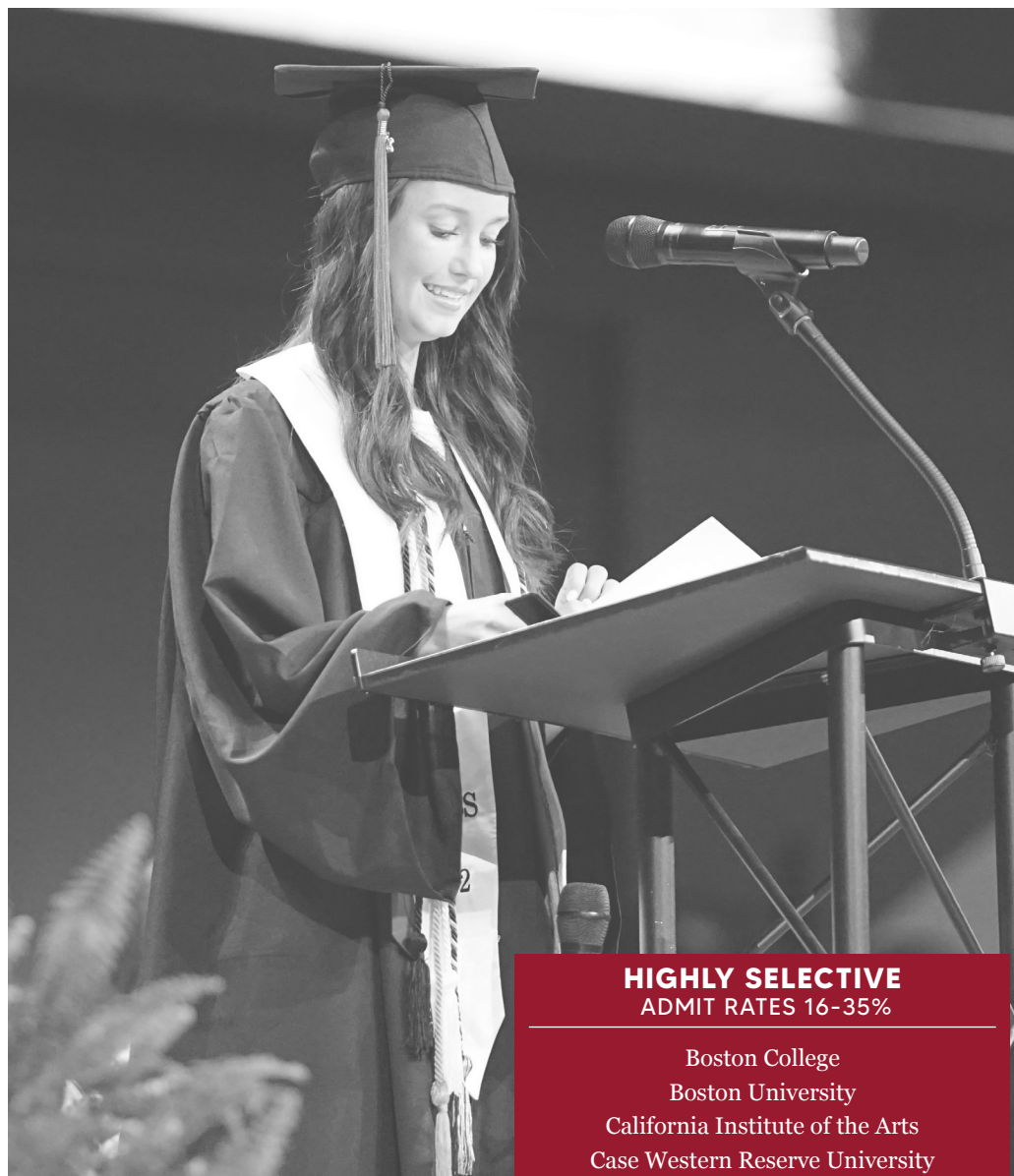
