OUR SCHOOL

Founded in 2001 with a little more than 30 preschool students, Crossings Christian School is now the largest private school in Oklahoma City with 1,100 students in preschool - 12th grades. The tremendous growth of CCS is indicative of our community's desire for a school with a college preparatory curriculum in a Christian environment.

OUR CURRICULUM

For the upper school, the academic program is organized by seven 50 minute class periods. The academic year is divided into two semesters, each approximately eighteen weeks in length. Students are required to take six, for-credit classes per semester. Oklahoma requires 23 credits to graduate. All CCS students must earn 24 credits to graduate and many earn the Distinguished Achievement diploma which requires 27 credits to graduate. In addition, each student must complete the 100-hour community service graduation requirement. *Program of Study on reverse.

GPA is computed using the above quality points. AP and Dual Credited classes are weighted an additional quality point. Honors and Pre-AP classes are weighted an additional 0.5 quality points.

Beginning with grade nine, all subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation.

With the exception of Valedictorian and Salutatorian, school policy eliminated class rank beginning with the class of 2011.

**To earn a Distinguished Achievement diploma at least one AP or Dual Credit class must be taken. Also, a student must earn either three credits in the same foreign language, or three credits in a concentrated specialty, or four credits of AP/Dual coursework.*

COVID-19 RESPONSE

Crossings Christian School continued its academic rigor and expectations throughout the spring 2020 semester. Attendance was taken, learning continued, assignments were graded, and tests/quizzes administered. Continuing with excellence, CCS utilized remote learning. Students earned grades that reflected their mastery of course content.
